

**Eleventh Sunday in Ordinary Time— June 17, 2018**

We hear about the Kingdom of God in many of Jesus' parables. In today's passage, he uses parables to describe how the kingdom will spread. What is interesting is that they are not so much about our actions as they are about how God builds his kingdom.

Let's start with the second parable: Jesus exaggerates a little, with the mustard seed being the smallest seed and the bush being the largest plant. Like the birds on the branches, Jesus implies that the growing kingdom will attract outsiders to be members. His point is that the kingdom may look small at first, but it will keep growing. We need not be discouraged when it seems the kingdom is not growing: We might be limiting it to people who think and act just like ourselves. We might see attendance at church in our parish declining. So Jesus is reminding us to think of the bigger picture.

In the first parable about the man who scattered seeds, Jesus says that those seeds produce a harvest, even though the farmer doesn't know how or why those seeds can grow. We too can be doing things that help the Kingdom to grow, without knowing how we are helping. But God is making the kingdom grow in his own way and in his own time. Like the farmer, we can help it grow by loving each other, teaching our children about Jesus, caring for the poor and the sick.

But we can also hinder the kingdom by being stingy with our love, or hurting people with our anger. So let us ask God to trust him as we do our part to help the kingdom to grow.

Dear Family:

Our Scriptures this weekend remind us that the Lord is at work in the world, in us, and in spreading God's Kingdom. The prophet Ezekiel addresses the people of Israel encouraging them never to lose hope. As God's people, they are assured that their fortunes will be reversed. The prophet offers a beautiful image: God takes a shoot from a cedar tree and plants it in the ground, where it grows into a majestic tree. In like manner, our loving God, whose power makes mighty trees grow, will restore the people of Israel.

"We walk by faith, and not by sight" is a call St. Paul addresses to his friends in Corinth: Remember that life is a journey to the Lord. No matter what happens Christ journeys with us. Our faith in Christ offers the confidence that we can face every challenge. Consequently, we are called to act in a way that pleases the Lord.

The Gospel presents two parables that focus on God's work within us and in the spread of God's Kingdom. In the first parable, Jesus compares the growth of God's Kingdom on earth to God's creative power working mysteriously in the world of nature. In the second parable, Jesus compares the growth of the Kingdom to a small mustard seed planted in the ground that becomes the largest of plants.

All these readings challenge us to remember that the work we do is ultimately not ours, but the Lord's. God works in mysterious ways within our lives and within the world in the growth of God's Kingdom. The future that lies ahead is mysterious, but is rooted in God's love for his people, beginning with the people of Israel and culminating with Jesus and the growth of the Christian Church.

Some questions for reflection:

- Reread the first sentence of the Second Reading carefully. What do you think Paul means by "We walk by faith and not by sight?"
- In your own life where have you seen God's mysterious power at work lately?
- How do the images of God's working in nature help you understand God's working in our lives?

Along with our celebration of the Eucharist this weekend, we are honoring our fathers on this Father's Day Weekend. We give thanks to our dads, and those who are like fathers to us who always remind us of God's loving care for all God's children. Let's celebrate our gratitude and pride in our dads and all they have given us. We keep in mind as well all whose dads have gone on to the other side of life. May they be blessed with peace in eternity with our loving God.

**I would also like to invite you all to join us for Tuesday evening Mass on June 19th when Bishop Sam Jacobs, Bishop Emeritus of the Diocese of Houma-Thibodeaux will celebrate the Eucharist and then lead us in a reflection of the work of the Holy Spirit in our studying and interpreting the words of Holy Scripture. There will be a reception in the Church Hall following Bishop Jacobs' talk. This event is open to the public. Please invite neighbors and friends to join us.**
