A Good Day to Die

Do you remember your own baptism? I wish I could. I envy the adults I have seen baptized at the Easter Vigil. Hopefully, they experience what St. Paul says in the epistle we hear at the Vigil. For Paul, Baptism is a sign of dying and rising to new life. Does that mean we will rise from the dead, too?

Yes, but that is not his main point. If all we think about is our physical death, and hope we go to heaven afterwards, we're missing the point. The new life starts with our baptism, not just our physical death. The water is both cleansing and a sign of dying (symbolic drowning) that help us see we are free from sin. We are dead to sin when we begin to live in Christ. The fictional Klingons have a saying "today is a good day to die" to express courage in battle. But real Christians might say that Easter is a good day to die to sin and live in Christ.

How do we experience this dying to sin? First, we identify the sinful areas of our life. Do I watch movies, or video games that encourage promiscuity, revenge, or selfishness? What sins do I confess repeatedly and what can I do to avoid them? As for living in Christ: Can I spend less time entertaining myself and more time in prayer? Instead of complaining about what is wrong with the world, can I find ways to make it better? These are a few of the ways we begin our new life in Christ.

Dear Family:

Jesus has been raised from the dead. Alleluia! Alleluia!

From today through the Solemnity of Pentecost, the First Reading each Sunday will be from the Acts of the Apostles. Here we will come to understand that Acts is the story of the early followers of Jesus, after his Resurrection. "These passages will focus only on the beginning of the early Church community. Today's reading opens with the words "Peter proceeded to speak and said." In Greek, these words are recognized as a particular literary form that lets the readers and the listeners know that what follows is inspired speech, similar to the Hebrew form in prophetic literature that begins "Thus says the Lord." The message that Peter proclaims is about God's great deeds in Jesus.

The four verses from Colossians in the Second Reading are part of a larger unit that began in the previous chapter and whose focus was more negative in tone than what we find here. These few lines encourage the community to turn their attention to Christ, with whom they are already united.

The Gospel passage is from select verses of a longer and powerful story that provide us with a brief and dramatic scene at the empty tomb. While verse 10, not included in today's reading, states that the disciples returned home, verse 11 tells us that Mary remained outside the tomb and wept. A beautiful encounter between Mary and the Risen Lord takes place within the next few verses.

Some thoughts for reflection;

How does the Resurrection impact the way that you live?

From our Bible, read the longer account of the Resurrection, John 20:1-18 or 1-29. Imagine yourself weeping and searching for Jesus.

If you heard Christ call your name, how do you imagine you would respond to him?

Many thanks for your great faithfulness to our Lenten journey. It has been a blessing to see so many of our faithful returning to worship as our fears in this pandemic diminish. For those who remain away until it is more safe, please know of our love for you and communion with you. You are prayed for daily at the Lord's Table.

Many thanks to our St. Joseph Altar Committee, our Knights of Columbus, and all who assisted in any way to our celebration of the Feast of St. Joseph. Many have expressed their appreciation for your dedication to bring some sense of solemnity and community even in these days of trial.

Many thanks to Mrs. Wanda Ashley and her team of Catechists, our St. John School Catechists, and all who made our celebrations of First Communion a life-giving event for our entire parish. Congratulations to our young people who received their First Communion and to their parents, guardians and family.

Also, thanks to our RCIA Team who worked diligently over this year to enable our new members to become one with us at the Table of the Lord. We congratulate our new members and their families. We look forward to their participation in the life and ministries of our parish.

Thanks to our St. John School teachers, administrators, support staff and students who once again shared their faith and gifts in the Walk With Jesus drawing us more deeply into the mystery of Christ's death and resurrection.

Thanks to our Altar Society, Catholic Daughters, decorating committee, and all our liturgical ministers. Your love for our church and her liturgies enable us to worship with zeal.

I am so filled with gratitude for our being able to celebrate the Resurrection of the Lord as a family gathered together. This was something we were not able to do last year. I suppose this writing may seem overly thankful, but I cannot help but be thankful in the Lord Jesus for where we are in this pandemic today. Knowing God's work in you, is cause for an Alleluia! The Lord is Risen Indeed!




